









Numerous methods for projecting gaming revenues, but some are better than others


- Basic Market Carve out Model
- Concentric Ring Analysis
- Benchmark Analysis
- Gravity Model (considered most advanced)

Gravity Model Methodology (Cont.)

- Is calibrated to current market conditions
- Predictive model for future revenues based on nationally expected trends in population and income
- Every casino in the market must be entered into the model.
- Cannibalization is a simple matter of subtracting a "With Competition" scenario from the "Without Competition" scenario.






Rings 10 mile radius






Kansas City with new Kansas Casino






Kansas City Proposed Casino













oThe Isle project in Cape Girardeau will produce *nearly* **twice** the incremental tax revenue for the state of Missouri as compared to the other applicants.








Monthly St. Louis Area Gaming Revenues

Missouri properties flat since River City opened







Annual Kansas City Area Gaming Revenues






- Greater Cape Girardeau market is <u>not</u>




Anchor for Downtown Revitalization

Gravity Model Methodology



 Based on Newton's Universal Law of Gravitation

Distance =
$$\sqrt{((C \text{ lat - B lat})^2 + (C \text{ lon - B lon})^2)}$$

The model calculates the likely visitation based on census and other factors after the model is calibrated to comparable facilities ?????

Gravity Model Methodology (Cont.)

- Advantages of Gravity Model:
 - Market split into block groups or zip codes
 - Adjusts for population density and variations in income
 - Instead of less than 10 markets, usually have over 1,000
- Main Inputs Include:
 - Propensity to gamble
 - % AAHI to Gaming
 - % Revenue to casino in market
 - Individual casino and market attraction factors
