

COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 16-039
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI

JUNE 29, 2016

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030 the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for conviction of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving morale turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313 RSMo or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, or performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming; or has their name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, Jane Windorski pled guilty and was convicted on December 9, 2015, in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of the State of Missouri of one felony count of Theft/Stealing, a felony involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to a total of five years in Missouri Department of Corrections with a Suspended Execution of Sentence, supervised probation of five years and restitution of \$10,952.87. Ms. Windorski admitted using the stolen funds for gambling. Ms Windorski also has an extensive gambling history at the Ameristar Casino, St. Charles in 2014, with wagers totaling \$392,719.72 and losses totaling \$44,111.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that Jane Windorski is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to Jane Windorski.
