COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 17-023
REGARDING FINDING OF SUITABILITY
AND LICENSURE OF ELDORADO RESORTS, INC.

April 26, 2017

WHEREAS, Eldorado Resorts, Inc. (“Eldorado”), has applied to the Missouri Gaming Commission (the “Commission”) for a Class A license to develop and operate Class B Licensees in the State of Missouri; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Commission hereby makes a finding that Eldorado, as a Class A Licensee, is suitable to develop and operate Class B Licensees, namely IOC – Boonville, Inc., who has a Class B License to operate Isle of Capri Casino Hotel Boonville; IOC – Kansas City, Inc., who has a Class B License to operate Isle of Capri Casino Kansas City; IOC – Caruthersville, LLC, who has a Class B License to operate Lady Luck Casino Caruthersville; and IOC – Cape Girardeau, LLC, who has a Class B License to operate Isle Casino Cape Girardeau; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to the applicant as provided herein shall be subject to full and complete compliance by the applicants with the Riverboat Gaming Act and Regulations, and subject to any and all conditions set forth or that may be set forth in the Riverboat Gaming Act and Regulations or by the Commission, from time to time; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to Eldorado as provided herein shall be subject to the Licensee maintaining all required governmental permits and approvals for the operation of its excursion gambling boats; and

RESOLVED, the license issued to Eldorado as provided herein shall be subject to any penalty or to suspension or revocation based on any pending or subsequent investigative findings by the Commission with regard to the Licensee, its agents, or employees; and

RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 313.807.1 RSMo, the Commission may, at any time, reopen the applicant’s licensing hearing; and

RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby issues a Class A license to Eldorado Resorts, Inc., for a period of one (1) year beginning on the date of this Resolution.
