IV. ASSUMPTIONS

Each company offering retail and mobile sports wagering will be charged \$6,000 annually for integrity monitoring services.
The commission anticipates that there will be 8 companies collectively obtaining the available Retail and Mobile licenses to offer sports wagering in the state of Missouri.
The annual fee is charged per company and not per license.
