

COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 14-082
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI

OCTOBER 29, 2014

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030, the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for conviction of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving morale turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313 RSMo or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, or performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming; or has their name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from, entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, Anthony M. Anderson, pled guilty on August 1, 2014 to one charge of Stealing over \$25,000, a Class B Felony and one count of Violation of Laws Pertaining to Riverboat Gambling, a Class D Felony in the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, Missouri, both felonies involving moral turpitude. Mr. Anderson was a dealer at the River City Casino. He confessed to the Missouri State Highway Patrol investigators that he had acted with three customers to help them cheat at blackjack games. Said act adversely affects public confidence and trust in Gaming and violates the provisions of Section 313.830 RSMo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that Anthony M. Anderson is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to Anthony M. Anderson.
