

**COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 14-009
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI**

February 26, 2014

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030 the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for the conviction of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving morale turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313 RSMo or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, or performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming; or has their name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from, entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, John A. Hartman, pled guilty and was convicted on December 2, 2013, of one Class C Felony count of Stealing over \$500, a felony involving moral turpitude in the Circuit Court of St. Louis County, Missouri for the theft of approximately \$15,873.56 during his employment as a manager of a company that operated parking garages at St. Mary's Hospital in Richmond Heights. Mr. Hartman stated that he used the money to fund what he described as a "very serious gambling binge". Mr. Hartman was sentenced to seven years with the Department of Corrections with a suspended execution of sentence and five years probation, The Court also ordered him to pay restitution in the amount of \$16,015.88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that John A. Hartman is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to John A. Hartman.
