

COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 15-057  
REGARDING EXCLUSION OF AN INDIVIDUAL FROM  
EXCURSION GAMBLING BOATS AND FACILITIES IN MISSOURI

NOVEMBER 4, 2015

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.030 the Missouri Gaming Commission (the "Commission") has the authority to place a person on the Exclusion List for conviction of a felony in any jurisdiction of any crime involving morale turpitude or of a crime involving gaming, violating any provision of Chapter 313 RSMo or any rule promulgated by the Missouri Gaming Commission, or performing any act or having a notorious or unsavory reputation which would adversely affect public confidence and trust in gaming; or has their name on any valid and current exclusion list from another jurisdiction in the United States and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 11 CSR 45-15.010, placement on the Exclusion List prohibits such person from, entering or having contact of any kind with any Missouri riverboat gaming operation; and

WHEREAS, Chad A. Arment, pled guilty and was convicted on August 17, 2015 in The Circuit Court of Lafayette County, Missouri of; three felony counts of Forgery, a Class C Felony 570.090, RSMo, a felony involving moral turpitude. He was sentenced to 15 years in the Missouri Department of Corrections on all three counts. The execution of the sentence was suspended pending successful completion of a 5 year term of supervised probation, a fine of \$1,000 and restitution to be determined. Mr. Arment also has an extensive gambling history at Mark Twain Casino from 2013 to 2015 with wagers totaling \$778,317, and at Hollywood Casino from 2013 to 2014, with wagers totaling \$13,558.51, and at Isle of Capri Boonville from 2013 to 2014, with wagers totaling \$107,184.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby finds that Chad A. Arment is eligible for permanent placement on the Exclusion List, and the Commission directs the Executive Director to issue a Notice of Exclusion to Chad A. Arment.
