IT IS AGREED AND STIPULATED as follows:


1. American Legion Post 153 will pay a fine of \$500.00, to be paid out of non-bingo proceeds. Said fine will be paid within 30 days of the Missouri Gaming Commission's approval of this Settlement Agreement.

2. American Legion Post 153 will remove and no longer have in its possession and control at any time any illegal and/or unapproved pull tabs or any other form of contraband

3. American Legion Post 153 will cease and desist from any and all sales of illegal and/or unapproved pull tabs or any other form of contraband not associated with a bingo occasion.

4. American Legion Post 153 will agree to obey all laws, including, but not limited to, those concerning the operation of Bingo games, and will cooperate fully with the MGC in all investigations and inquiries into its bingo operations and license.
