PROPOSED AMENDMENT

11 CSR 45-12.060 Renewal

PURPOSE: This amendment removes the Appendix and requires the use of the commission's form.

(1) Within thirty (30) days of the expiration date, each excursion liquor licensee shall register *[on]* **for renewal of its license using** forms provided by the **Missouri Gaming Commission** *[commission, for renewal of its license (see Appendix A)]*.
